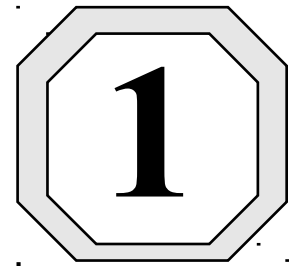

Every Westercon has a business meeting; we have to, it's in the constitution and everything. At WC69 it will be held at 11am on Saturday in the Ross Island room.

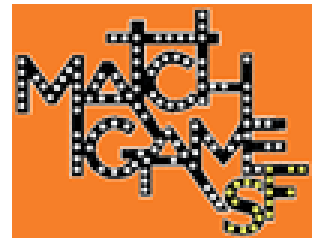

Westercon is governed by a set of bylaws (published in the Program Book), and every member of Westercon may attend the Business Meeting where changes to the Westercon Bylaws are proposed, debated, and voted upon. Currently, the only scheduled business is a proposal to reduce the quorum (minimum number of members required to hold a legal meeting) from 15 to 10 members. Other new business can be introduced at the meeting. If necessary (check newsletter) a special Site Selection meeting will be held on Sunday; however, it is unlikely that such a meeting will be necessary...

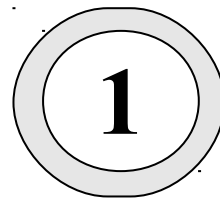


Creation Station News
